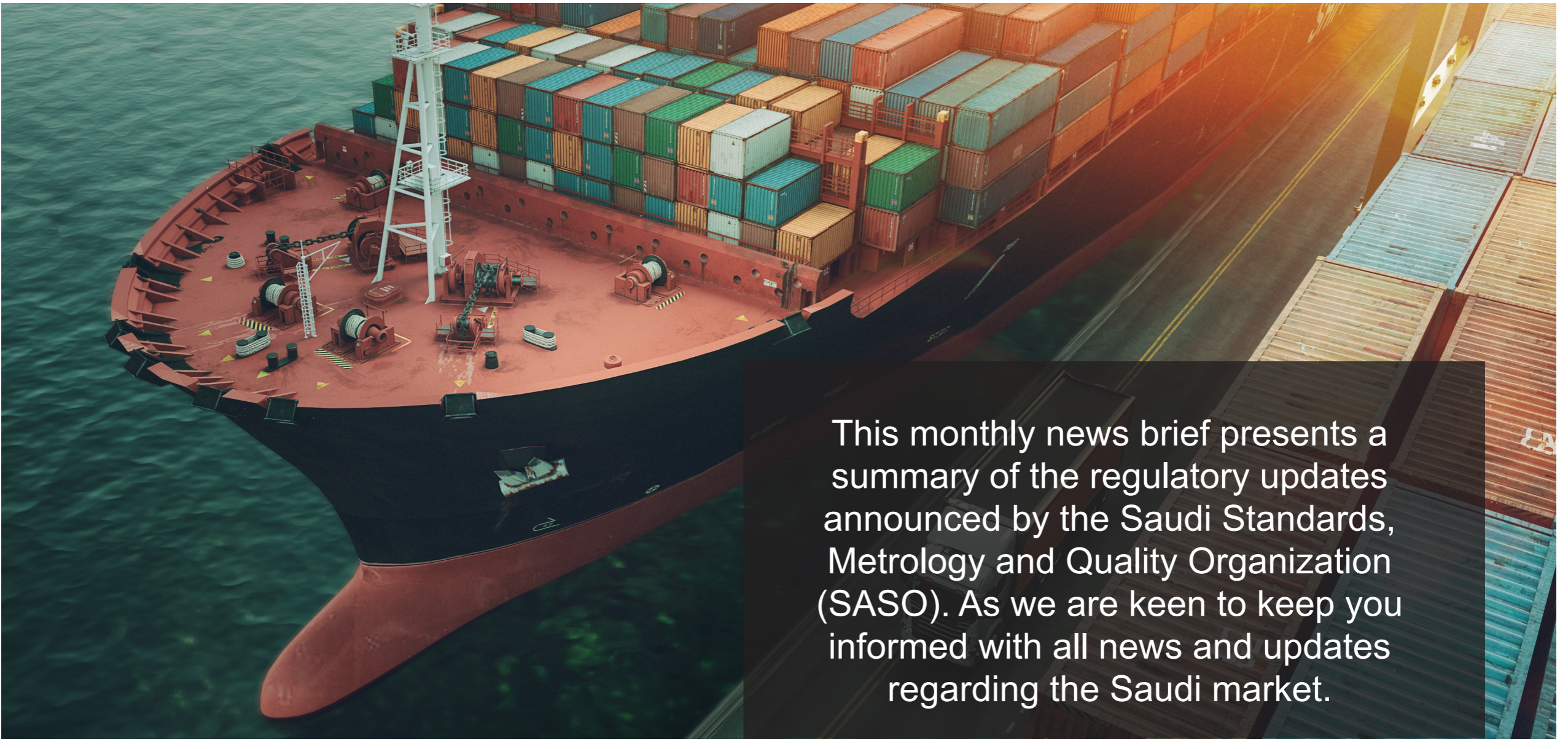


# June News Brief



This monthly news brief presents a summary of the regulatory updates announced by the Saudi Standards, Metrology and Quality Organization (SASO). As we are keen to keep you informed with all news and updates regarding the Saudi market.



## Tabseer presented a webinar on "The Requirements of Exporting to Saudi Arabia" in cooperation with the Textile Export Council

Tabseer held a webinar in cooperation with the Egypt Textiles and Home Textiles Export Council on the requirements of exporting textile products to Saudi Arabia.

The webinar covered many topics including introduction to Saber Electronic Platform, and the conformity certificates required for the Saudi market according to the regulatory framework.



## SASO announces mandatory start dates for submitting technical files and photos on Saber

The Saudi Standards, Metrology and Quality Organization announced mandatory dates for submitting technical files on Saber Electronic Platform, which will be from June 23, 2022, and all accepted conformity assessment bodies will have to submit the following data on Saber before issuing the product certificate of conformity, including:

- Conformity Assessment (Type 1a): (Test Report, Risk Assessment Document).
- Conformity Assessment (Type 3): (Test Report, Risk Assessment Document, Factory Audit Report).

For the nonregulated products, SASO announced that it will be mandatory to add photos when they are registered on Saber starting from 17 June 2022.



## Zakat, Tax and Customs launches the automatic adjustment service for shipping bills and containers at all sea ports

The Zakat, Tax and Customs Authority launched the service of automatic approval of requests for deletion and addition of shipping bills and containers in the export manifests, in cooperation with the General Authority of Ports "Mawani" to include the service in all ports of the Kingdom.

The new service aims to enable navigational agents to obtain automatic approval for amendment requests on shipping bills and containers.



## Mawani announces the addition of new shipping services at King Abdulaziz Port

The General Ports Authority (Mawani) announced the addition of Pacific International Lines (PIL) for Shanghai Port and Singapore Port to the Direct Shipping Service (GCS) at King Abdulaziz Port, which links China to the Arabian Gulf region, contributing to increasing the capacity available to support import and export operations.

This comes in line with the aim of shipping lines to expand and add new shipping services that enhance the level of competitiveness.



## SASO organizes the Eighth National Quality Conference under the slogan "Sustainable Quality... For an Ambitious Nation."

The Saudi Standards, Metrology and Quality Organization organized the National Quality Conference in its eighth edition, under the slogan "Sustainable Quality.. for an ambitious nation ", from 6 to 8 June 2022, at the King Salman International Convention Centre in Madinah.

The conference witnessed the participation of more than 70 speakers through 16 sessions.



## The GCC Standardization Organization organizes the training program on the standards for solar cells

The GCC Standardization Organization organized a training program on the standards for solar cells (renewable energy), as part of the training programs for the Gulf Standardization Training Center for 2022, hosted generously by the State of Qatar represented by the Qatar General Organization for Standardization and Standardization.

The training program aims to enhance the technical expertise of specialists and interested persons in the field of preparing and applying renewable energy standards and storage techniques.
