1444/15/9 AH, the adoption of new technical regulations according to the following: The Technical Regulations for Watercraft

This regulation aims to define the basic requirements for the recreational watercraft products included in the scope of this technical regulation and to specify the conformity assessment procedures

that suppliers must adhere to ensure that these products comply with the requirements that aim to preserve the environment and health the safety of its users, and the facilitation of market survey procedures. Technical Regulation for Standby and Sleep Mode for Electronic Devices This regulation aims to decrease energy consumption to preserve resources and the national

SFDA Obtains Certificate of Accreditation for Inspection

The Food and Drug Authority (SASO) has obtained an accreditation certificate for the fifth year in a row in the field of Inspection of the following Facilities:

In addition to increasing the scope of accreditation this year to include central clearing centers and border crossings, following the requirements of the International Standard for Inspection (ISO/IEC 17020). : 2012). The authority stated that this standard is considered the Primary Standard for International Accreditation Bodies and the International Standards recognized worldwide in Inspection.
