Technical proficiency tests in the Gulf were first offered by the **National Center for Measurement** and Calibration المركز الوطنى للقياس والمعايرة National Measurement & Calibration Center The laboratories of the Technical Proficiency Testing Unit at the National Center for Measurement and Calibration at the Saudi Standards, Metrology and Quality Organization have obtained the accreditation of the Saudi Accreditation Center (SAAC) by the requirements of the specification (ISO17043), as the first provider of technical proficiency tests in the field of measurement and calibration at the Gulf level. The accreditation included 37 qualitative technical programs provided by the centre, reflecting its commitment to excellence and quality in providing technical services, and enhancing the Kingdom's position as a pioneer in this field at the regional level.
